

3. Overnight at a treetops style lodge to enhance your viewing of the local wildlife safely, comfortably and up-close.
4. Visit 2 UNESCO sites :
  - 1) Tanzania's Ngorongoro Conservation Area (declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1979)
  - 2) Tanzania's Serengeti National Park (declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1981)
5. Visit 5 National Parks and 2 reserve and conservation areas:
  - 1) Kenya : Aberdare National Park, Lake Nakuru National Park, Amboseli National Park and Masai Mara National Reserve.
  - 2) Tanzania : Serengeti National Park, Lake Manyara National Park and Ngorongoro Conservation Area.
6. Special boat ride on Lake Naivasha. You will be able to see hippos and during the hot time of the day they will be sleeping on the shallow ends.

Jambo na Karibu! Welcome to Nairobi, or the "place of cool waters" in the Maasai language. Meet our representative at the main arrival hall and be transferred to your hotel.

Start your African adventure with a full day city tour. Visit the ★**NAIROBI NATIONAL MUSEUM**, the flagship brand for the National Museums of Kenya, where it showcases Kenya's rich Heritage with four distinct themes representing Kenya's Culture, Nature, History and Contemporary Art. Other attraction within the compound is the ★**SNAKE PARK**, created in 1961 to meet a popular attraction and to provide a research facility on reptiles and for breeding of snakes. Visit ★**KAREN BLIXEN HOUSE**, once the centre piece of a farm at the foot of the Ngong Hills owned by Danish Author Karen and her Swedish Husband, Baron Bror von Blixen Fincke. The farm house gained international fame with the release of the movie 'Out of Africa' an Oscar winning film based on Karen's autobiography. Continue on a visit to ★**BOMAS OF KENYA**, a tourist village displaying traditional villages belonging to the several Kenyan tribes. At Bomas, different aspects of Kenyan culture are displayed including living styles, crafts, music and the most exciting traditional dances and acrobatic show.

Drive to the ★**ABERDARE NATIONAL PARK**, a beautiful mountain range in the central highlands of Kenya. Enjoy a stay at a world's famous treetops style lodge, where you will spend the rest of the afternoon on game viewing from your lodge's balcony. The original treetops lodge concept was to provide a hunting platform, overlooking a waterhole and salt lick near the animals. We chose to stay at this lodge to enhance your experience, so that you can observe the local wildlife up-close and comfortably.



Today drive to ★**LAKE NAKURU NATIONAL PARK**, famous as the home to thousands of lesser and greater flamingo (migratory and numbers vary from time to time). This park also provides sanctuary for the Rothschild giraffe, rhino and leopard. This afternoon, enjoy a game drive, and return before sunset.

Today depart Lake Nakuru with packed lunch boxes and arrive in the fresh water Lake Naivasha, which draws a good number of wildlife to its shores, including giraffe, buffalo, and colobus monkeys. See the beauty of Lake Naivasha and relax as you go on a ★**BOAT RIDE**. You will be able to see hippos and during the hot time of the day they will be sleeping on the shallow ends. Continue your journey to Masai Mara.

Today enjoy a full day in ★**MASAI MARA** game reserve with morning and afternoon game drives. Look out for lions, leopards, cheetahs, elephants, zebras, and countless birds that frequent the Mara’s grasslands. Later visit the ★**MASAI VILLAGE** to experience their culture, traditions, and lifestyle. The Maasai are semi-nomadic people with distinctive customs and dress. They are famous for their fearsome reputations as warriors and cattle-rustlers, and their ability to farm in deserts and scrublands.

Depart with packed lunch boxes and drive via Isebania border, where you will clear customs and immigrations and change vehicles. Proceed with your Tanzania vehicle and guide to arrive early for check-in, followed by dinner.

Drive to your lodge in central **★SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK** with morning and afternoon game drives. The Serengeti National Park entered UNESCO’s World Heritage List in 1981. The vast plains of the Serengeti comprise 1.5 million ha of savannah. The annual migration to permanent water holes of vast herds of herbivores (wildebeest, gazelles and zebras), followed by their predators, is one of the most impressive natural events in the world.



<b>Day 10</b>	<b>Serengeti → Olduvai Gorge → Ngorongoro</b>

Start your journey with packed lunch boxes and stop by **★OLDUVAI GORGE**, one of the most important paleoanthropological sites in the world, where anthropologists Louis and Mary Leakey made many significant discoveries, contributing to the theory that human life originated in Africa.



Continue to **★NGORONGORO CONSERVATION AREA**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Descend below the rim of the **★NGORONGORO CRATER**, the world’s largest free-standing caldera. On the crater floor, enjoy a game drive to experience one of the densest concentrations of wildlife in Africa.

Serengeti –(126km)– Olduvai Gorge –(42km)– Ngorongoro

<b>Day 11</b>	<b>Ngorongoro → Lake Manyara National Park → Amboseli National Park, Kenya</b>

Accommodation	Oi Tukai Lodge or similar

Drive to **★LAKE MANYARA NATIONAL PARK** with packed lunch boxes. Upon arrival, enjoy a game drive through this park, renowned among birders for huge flocks of pink flamingos, as well as giraffes, baboons, hippos, and elephants. Continue on to the Namanga border, where you will clear customs and immigrations and change vehicles. Proceed with Kenya vehicle and guide to **★AMBOSELI NATIONAL PARK**, and enjoy an afternoon game drive. This park is set against the magnificent backdrop of Africa's highest mountain, Mount Kilimanjaro, and it’s famous for being the best place in Africa to get close to free-ranging elephants. Amboseli’s system of swamps makes this low-rainfall area one of the best wildlife-viewing experiences in the world with 400 species of birds including water birds, pelicans, kingfishers, crakes, hammerkops and 47 types of raptor.

Today enjoy a full day in ★**AMBOSELI NATIONAL PARK**, with morning and afternoon game drives. Amboseli offers some of the best opportunities to see African animals because its vegetation is sparse due to the long dry months. This park is home to wild animals, which include the African elephant, cape buffalo, impala, lion, cheetah, hyena, giraffe, zebra, and wildebeest. There is also a host of Kenyan birds, both large and small, to see if you keep your eyes open and stop at every sighting. The park has several rules to protect the wildlife: do not get out of your vehicle, except at designated spots; do not harass the animals in any way; keep to the tracks; no off-road driving; and animals always have the right of way. The roads in Amboseli have a loose surface of volcanic soil that is dusty in the dry season and impassable in the wet season.




Day 13	Amboseli National Park → Nairobi → USA

Today enjoy a morning game drive in ★**AMBOSELI**, followed by early lunch. Later, proceed to Nairobi and have dinner at the famous ★**CARNIVORE RESTAURANT**, an open-air meat specialty restaurant that has become a standard stop on the safari trail. Every type of meat imaginable, including four choices of wild game, is roasted on traditional Maasai swords (skewers) over a huge, visually spectacular charcoal pit that dominates the entrance of the restaurant. The waiters carry these swords around the restaurant, carving unlimited amounts of the prime meats onto sizzling, cast iron plates in front of you. A wide selection of salads, vegetable side dishes, and a variety of exotic sauces accompany the meat feast.

After dinner, it is time to bid farewell to your tour guide and new travel friends, as your safari adventure comes to an end. Transfers to Jomo Kenyatta International airport are available. Conditions apply.

## TERMS & CONDITIONS

### Reservations and Payments

Payment of the deposit and/or full payment indicates acceptance of our Terms and Conditions.

1. Deposit: **USD 500** per person. Reservation is subject to cancellation if the deposit is not received by Unikke Travel within 7 days after booking.
2. Final payment: due **60 days** prior to departure date. Payment in full is required at time of booking for reservations made less than 60 days prior to departure date. If your payment is not received by the due date, the reservation is subject to cancellation and deposit will be forfeited.

### Handling and Revision Fees

A fee of **USD 35** per person will be charged for any change made after your booking is confirmed. Any changes risk the loss of space or increased fares. Name changes or corrections will be treated as a cancellation of air; all normal air cancellation fees will apply (up to 100%). A change of travel date or itinerary within 60 days of departure will be treated as a cancellation and new booking; regular cancellation fees apply. Bookings made within **15 days** of departure incur special handling fees.

### Passenger Cancellation & Cancellation Fees

Written notice of cancellation must be received by Unikke Travel either by mail, fax, or email.

The following penalties will be assessed when you cancel your reservation:

- 90-76 days prior to departure: 8% of total price
- 75-46 days prior to departure: 15% of total price
- 45-31 days prior to departure: 30% of total price
- 30-15 days prior to departure: 40% of total price
- Within 14 days, including no shows: 100% of total price

In addition to the above stated cancellation charges, if tickets for airlines, cruises or trains have already been issued or final confirmation has been received at the time of cancellation (regardless of number of days prior to departure), you will be assessed an additional airline, cruise line, or train cancellation penalty (up to 100%) and service charge according to the supplier's rules and regulations.

Should a passenger sharing a room cancel, the remaining passenger(s) will be charged for a single (or twin share) room.

Unikke Travel reserves the right to issue airline tickets at any time after receipt of your deposit.

### Refunds for Unused Services

No refunds will be made for unused services once travel has commenced. If you leave your vacation early due to illness, you must obtain a medical certificate in support of any insurance claim. We regret that no refunds can be made for absences from a program, including but not limited to, missed meals or sightseeing. Employees of any domestic or overseas service supplier are not authorized to indicate or make refunds without respect to Unikke Travel's stated Terms and Conditions.

### Escorted Tour Cancellation

Unikke Travel reserves the right to cancel or reschedule any departure in accordance with operating requirements or circumstances beyond its control. We will try to rebook the same or a similar vacation and, where flights have been confirmed by us, we will attempt to confirm an air schedule for the new dates, subject to availability. If there is a difference in cost, it will be at the passenger's expense. If the alternative trip is not accepted within 7 days, we will refund all monies paid to Unikke Travel and will be under no further obligation or liability. If cancellation is made any time prior to departure, Unikke Travel's only liability will be to refund to the passenger the amount it has received for the booking.

Unikke Travel is not liable for any other travel arrangements affected due to our cancellations or any cancellation penalties incurred on any other travel arrangements including air tickets purchased separately. If purchasing a non-refundable air ticket, please make sure your Travel Agent explains the difficulties associated

### Visas & Passports

All passengers traveling internationally are required to have a passport. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months beyond the conclusion of your trip. It is recommended that you have a minimum of three blank pages in your passport when traveling, as many countries require blank pages.

You are responsible for obtaining and paying for all visas and entry documents, for meeting all health and other requirements, and for any documents required by the laws, regulations, orders, and/or requirements of the countries you will visit. Multiple-entry visas are required for some vacations. It is your responsibility to verify all visa and passport requirements.

Non-U.S. citizens must consult with appropriate consulates to determine if any visas are needed.

Unikke Travel is not responsible for providing you with specific visa and passport information or documentation, for any fees associated with obtaining these documents, and we cannot accept liability for any passenger who is refused entry onto any transportation or into any country due to failure of the passenger to carry correct documentation.

The process of obtaining a visa and/or passport can take up to three months or more. Some government agencies in foreign countries require us to collect and pass on certain personal and other details related to you, including but not limited to government-issued identification and passport details. If you fail to supply the details as requested, fully and accurately, your trip may be interrupted or cancelled. There are no refunds for failure to provide documentation or failure to provide documentation by the time required.

### Physical Fitness

Please consult with your physician regarding your wellness and ability to travel long distances, as some locations and sightseeing activities require extensive standing, sitting or walking.

When visiting high-altitude destinations or countries that require vaccination, you should discuss the trip with your physician prior to departing the United States.
